For 1919. Fixing the compensation of the City Marshal, City Attorney and Recorder was read the first time in full and on motion and roll call, all members present voting ye, was read the second time by title only. On the question shall the bill be read the third time now, the roll was called and all members present voting ye; the bill was read the third time.

On the question shall the bill pass, the roll was called, and all members voting ye, the Mayor declared the bill passed.

There being no objection the title of the bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance. The claim of Mrs Stella Hall, for One Thousand dollars (1000⁰⁰), for injuries claimed to have been sustained by her, from falling on a sidewalk on East Grant Street, was read and on motion was referred to the Auditing Committee for investigation.

The Street Committee tasked for further time in which to report on the establishment and location of lights as petitioned for.
