Ordinance bill # 15 for 1920. fixing the com-
 pensation of the Mayor, and Members of the
 Common Council. Of the City of Lebanon.
 was read, the first, second, and third times
 in regular order, and passed: all the members
 of the Council voting yea. on the several roll
 calls: There being no objections, the title of the
 bill, was declared to be the Title of the Ordinance.
 On motion by S O Wallace, The Lebanon Light and Water
 Co were ordered to establish a Fire Hydrant
 at Third and A Streets and one at 4th and Grant
 Street;

The City Attorney was instructed to investigate
 Franchise and Contract, with the Lebanon Light
 and Water Co. and if possible, compel them
 to give the City, adequate water pressure.

On motion by Burtenshaw, The Fire Chief
 was instructed to request The Lebanon Lumber
 Co to organize a fire company among their
 employees, to assist in ^{fire} protection.
