Council met in regular session.

Major B. J. Millsap presiding
All members of the Council present
Minutes of previous meeting read and approved
Notice by the Public Service Commission
of increase of rates granted the Lebanon
Telephone Co. was read and placed
in file.

The claim of Elsie Egger for \$25.00 for damages
claimed to have been caused by fall on a defective
sidewalk was read.

On motion the claim was not allowed;
Communication from State Fire Marshall in
reference to convention of Fire Chiefs to be held
at Los Angeles Sept 18th was read, and
placed on file.

On motion by B. L. Cotton that the City pay
the expenses of Fire Chief R. E. Gilmore to attend
the convention was carried.

The Fire Chief reported the following Fire hydrants
out of service: one at 3rd and Tengert Streets;
one at Grove and Oak Street, and one at Sherman
and Second Streets; and also a leaking main
pipe on North Street.

On motion of B. L. Cotton the City Attorney
was instructed to prepare a resolution ordering
the removal of the building located on parts
of Lots #3 and #4 in Block #4 of the original
Townsite of Lebanon.

The matter of establishing lights in the alleys
of the business district was referred to the
Committee on Streets and Public Property.
The following bills were read and on motion were
allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the
City Treasurer for the several amounts.
