Minutes of previous meeting read and approved

Notice by the Public Service Commission of increase of rates, granted the Lebanon Mutual Telephone Co. was read and placed on file.

A claim of Edie Egger for \$25.00 for damages claimed to have been caused by fall on a defective sidewalk. was read;

On motion the claim was not allowed;

Communication from State Fire Marshall in reference to convention of Fire Chiefs to be held in Los Angeles. Sept 13th was read, and placed on file.

A motion by B L Cotton, ^{that} the City pay the expenses of Fire Chief R L Gilson to attend the convention, was carried.

The Fire Chief reported the following fire hydrants out of repair: one at B and Turrent Streets; one at Grover and Oak Street, and one at Sherman and Second Streets; and also a leaking main pipe on North Hiatt Street.

On motion of B L Cotton, the City Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution ordering the removal of the building located on parts of Lots # 3 and 4 in Block # 4 of the original Townsite of Lebanon.

The matter of Establishing Lights in the Alleys of the Business district, was referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property.
