

Lebanon, Ohio, Sept 31st 1920

Council met in regular session.

Mayor Byers called presiding
Councilman present on roll call:

A J Landall, D O Wallace, B L Cotton
H W Kimmel and L A Tucker.

Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved.

The Committee on Health and Police reported,
on bill of H C Lowe, for 23⁰⁰ for Demolition
building that had been referred to them at
previous meeting: recommended that the bill
be not allowed.

The City Attorney reported that the owner of
the Building located on parts of Lot #3 & 4,
Block #4: had made arrangements to post
of same removed at once.

J C Mayer & A M Reeves, as members of the
Strawberry Fair Committee reported that there
was on hand about \$400⁰⁰, that had been
received by them for concessions sold. that had
been granted them at various times by the
City, and that they would like to turn
the same to the City for the use of the Park
Commissioner.

On Motion the offer was accepted and the
Park Commissioner authorized to use the money
for the improvement of the City Park.

A Petition for the improvement of North Second
street between Tongue and May Street, was
read and referred to the Committee on Streets
and Public Property.

Councilman Cotton reported the light at
intersection of 2nd and Maple Street, out
of repair.

The matter of paving concrete Bridge and
repair of pavement was referred to the
Committee on Streets and Public
Property.

The City Attorney was instructed to notify
the S O R R Co. of the unsatisfactory condition
of the street and side walk crossings
on Grove, Williams and Shatt Streets.
