The bill of Dr R Bruce Miller for \$15⁰⁰ for Salary as Health Officer for 1919 was read and allowed in the sum of \$10⁰⁰, the amount as provided by Ordinance, and warrant ordered drawn for that amount.

The bill of The Lebanon E L & Water Co for \$285⁰⁰ for Light & Water for Sept was read. a deduction of \$13.15 from the amount of the bill for defective Hydrants and Lights was ordered and bill allowed for the balance and warrant ordered drawn for \$272.45

The bill of Dr R B Miller for extra services as health officer was read and referred to the committee on Health and Police.

The bill of Fire Chief R L Gelson for expense attending the Fire Chiefs Convention at Los Angeles. was read, and referred to the City Attorney, with instructions to prepare an Ordinance, authorizing the payment of the same.
