

Lebanon Ore Oct 19th 1920

Council met in regular session

Mayor Byron Millsaps presiding.

All members of the Council present
Minutes of the previous meeting read
and approved.

Report of the Recorder for the 3rd Quarter
read, accepted and placed on file.

The City Attorney reported that the owners
of lots #1 and 2, in Block #1, had arranged
for the laying of Sidewalk, as ordered by
the Council, and further action by the
City officials was unnecessary.

Petitions for a Light at 4th and A Street
and one at the Rail Road Crossing on
Eddy Street, was read and referred to
the Committee on Streets and Public Property.
Ordinance bill #17 for 1920, appropriating
money to pay the expenses of Fire Chief
R L Gilson, to attend the Fire Chiefs
convention at Los Angeles, was read
the first, second, and third times in
regular order, and passed, all the
members of the Council, voting yes on
the several roll calls.

The Fire Chief suggested that some kind
of heating apparatus would be necessary
for the Fire Truck during cold weather.
The matter was referred back to the Chief
for further investigation as to methods
and costs.

The Superintendent of Streets was authorized
to order the Sewer Pipe necessary to con-
nect the Sewer with the Canal, for flushing
purpose, and to have same laid at once.

The following bills were read, allowed, and
warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer
for the several amounts.
