Council met in regular session
The Mayor being absent Councilman
A J Crandall was elected Mayor Pro Tem
Councilmen present on roll call
A J Crandall, B L Cotton, S O Wallace
W W Kimmel and L A Tucker.
Mayor Millsaps and Councilman Burtuska
appeared after roll call and were marked
present.

The committee on Streets and Public
Property reported favorable on application
for the improvement of Third Street from
Tangent Street north to Mary Street.
And the City Attorney was instructed
to prepare a resolution authorizing the
improvement as prayed for.

Report on petition for lights at Fourth
and A Streets, and at Rail Road crossing
on Eddy Street, was unfavorable.

Report accepted, and adopted as the
sense of the Council.

On Motion the City Attorney was instructed
to furnish the Mayor and Council a
written opinion on regards the power
of the Council to compel the Lebanon
Electric Light and Water Company to furnish
lights and water, as ordered by the Council.

The Budget committee was appointed as
follows: W W Kimmel, B L Cotton and
S O Wallace. Intermission.
