

Lebanon Ore. Nov 16th 1920

Council met in regular session with Mayor Byron Hallsafe presiding; all members of the Council present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The written opinion of City Attorney Newport as to authority of the Council to compel The Leb Electric Light and Water Co. to install lights as ordered by the Council. was read and on motion was accepted and placed on file.

On Motion the City Attorney was instructed to notify the Officials of the Light and Water Co. that the service was unsatisfactory and specify the Fire Hydrants that are out of repair, and the failure to furnish two additional Hydrants and the neglect to furnish additional lights as ordered, and failure to keep lights already installed in proper condition.

Ordering estimates of cost of the improvement of Third Street ~~from~~ Tanager Street, North to Third Street, was read and passed. all members of the Council voting yes. on roll call.

Estimates of costs of Improvement of Third Street, and the probable cost to be paid by the City of Lebanon; and the cost to be assessed to the property specially benefitted thereby, was read and accepted.

Authorizing the Improvement of Third Street from Tanager Street North to Main Street, according to the plans, and estimates of costs of same as furnished by the Superintendent of Streets, and the City Engineer, was read, and on roll call was passed all the members of the Council voting yes.
