

Lebanon Ore Nov 30th 1920

Council met as per Adjournment

Mayor Byron Millsap presiding
Councilmen present, A J Grandall,
J M Bustershaw, S O Wallace, B L
Kotton and W W Kimmel.

Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved.

The Superintendent of Streets reported
that the S. P. R. R. Co. was willing to
pay One Hundred dollars (\$100⁰⁰) for having
Sherman Street, Graveled, between Third
and Fourth Streets; and estimated that
a good job could be done for that amount.
He was authorized to have the work
done.

Mr J G Reed called the attention of
the Council to the condition of the
drainage from Grant Street North;
that drain had been closed, causing
surface water to overflow his property;
referred to Com. on Streets & Public Property
and Supt of Streets.

Petition for Electric Lights on Tanager
Streets was read.

Resolution # 14 for 1920, adopting the

Budget of expenditures for 1921; as
reported by the Budget Committee on
Nov 2nd was read; and on roll call
was passed; all the members of the
Council voting yes.

The matter of providing hitching racks
for teams, was discussed; and referred
to the Com. on Streets and Public Property.
