

Lebanon On Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 1920

Council met as per Adjournment

Mayor Byron Tullisap presiding  
Councilmen present A J Crandall;  
M Bustenshaw; S O Wallace; B L  
Cotton and W H Kimmel.

Minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved.

The Superintendent of Streets reported  
that the S.P. R.R. Co. was willing to  
pay One Hundred dollars (\$100<sup>00</sup>) for having  
Herman Street Graveled, between Third  
and Fourth Streets; and estimated that  
a good job could be done for that amount.  
He was authorized to have the work  
done.

Mr J G Reed called the attention of  
the Council to the condition of the  
drainage from Grant Street North:  
that drain had been closed, causing  
surface water to overflow his property.  
Referred to Com. on Streets & Public Property  
and Sup't of Streets.

Petition for Electric Lights on Tengent  
streets was read:

Budget 1921.

Resolution #14 for 1920, adopting the  
Budget of Expenditures for 1921; as  
reported by the Budget Committee on  
Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> was read and on roll call  
was passed; all the members of the  
Council voting yes.

The matter of providing hitching racks  
for teams, was discussed; and referred  
to the Com. on Streets and Public Property.
