

Lebanon Dec 7th 1920

Council met in regular session. Mayor Byron Millsap presiding.

All members of the Council present
Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved as read.

The Dept of Streets made verbal report on drain-
age on East Grant Street, complained of by
Mr Reed.

An Ordinance providing for the clearing of ice
and snow of sidewalks, and for the repair of
dangerous sidewalks, and providing a penalty
and punishment for persons violating the
ordinance was read in regular order
and passed all the members of the Council
voting aye, on the several roll calls:

There being no objections the Title of the bill
was declared to be the title of the Ordinance.

On Motion of W I Crandall, duly seconded
The City Engineers and Dept of Streets were
instructed to install four concrete pedestals
for lights at the New Concrete Bridge on
Main Street, and to have lights installed
thereon; The Electric Co, through Mr Stewart
who was present, agreeing to furnish current
for two lights free of expense to the City.
On motion of D O Wallace duly seconded,
permission was granted to construct

a temporary wooden side walk on Maple
Street abutting Lot #1, Block #1, the same
to be removed at discretion of the Council.
