

Lebanon On Aug. 16th 1921

Council met in regular session. Mayor Byron Millspaugh presiding.

All members of the Council being present.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.
Special committee reported that additional water
was being turned into Stark Slough; and that
with dredging now being done the conditions
at the outlet of the sewer system, would be greatly
improved.

The report of the City Engineer and Capt. of Street
on the improvement of 2nd Street from Oak Street to
the South City limits, was read, and Resolution
28 for 1921, accepting and confirming the report.

And levying an assessment against the several
parcels of real property especially benefitted by the
said improvement, and adopting and confirm-
ing the assessment roll, was read, and
adopted, on roll call, all the members of the
Council voting aye.

Total cost of the Improvement \$ 951.82

To be paid by the City of Lebanon. \$ 144.10

To be paid by the Property Owners. \$ 807.73

Committee of Streets & Public property reported that
estimate of expense of repairing Bituminous pavement
and other paving proposed, would be secured in
a few days.

A complaint of the grade of sidewalks on Elmwood
street was referred to the Com. on Streets & Public
Property.

A motion prevailed that the Council request the
State Fire Marshall to make a visit^{up} personal to Lebanon
and investigate conditions.
