

Lebanon Ors Aug. 16<sup>th</sup> 1921

Council met in regular session. Mayor Byron Millsaps presiding. All members of the Council being present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Special Committee reported that additional water was being turned into Mark Slough and that with dredging now being done the conditions at the outlet of the sewer system, would be greatly improved.

The report of the City Engineer and Supt of Street on the improvement of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from Oak Street to the South City limits, was read, and Resolution # 28 for 1921 accepting and confirming the report and levying an assessment against the several parcels of real property especially benefited by the said improvement, and adopting and confirming the assessment roll, was read, and adopted. on roll call, all the members of the Council voting aye:

To be paid by the City of Lebanon	\$ 144.10
To be paid by the Property Owners	\$ 807.72

Committee on Streets & Public Property: reported that estimate of expense of repairing Bethelitic pavement and other paving proposed, would be secured in a few days.

A complaint of the grade of sidewalks on Elmore Street was referred to the Com. on Streets & Public Property.

A motion prevailed that the Council request the State Fire Marshall to make a <sup>visit to</sup> personal to Lebanon and investigate conditions.
