

Lebanon, Oregon, November 25th, 1921

Council of the City of Lebanon met in special session at the call of the Mayor, with Mayor Byron Millsap presiding and all members of the Council being present, with N. M. Newport acting as recorder pro tem.

It was moved and seconded and duly carried that the City require the Lebanon Electric Light and Water Company, or the owners of the Lebanon and Santiam Canal to replace the bridge on East Grant Street across the said canal, recently washed out, and the City attorney was instructed to give proper notice to the company to that effect, and that it is the purpose of the City of Lebanon to require the said Company to maintain all bridges over the canal on the streets of Lebanon where there were streets at the time of the construction of the said canal and where the said canal cut through the said streets.

It was moved and carried that the Street Superintendent receive open bid for replacing the foot bridge on east side of Williams Street over the Lebanon and Santiam Canal, recently washed out, and that he proceed at once to replace crosswalks and repair hole cut in street by recently high water.

The City attorney was instructed to prepare amendment to fire limit ordinance in the manner agreed upon by the council in an informal discussion of said matter.

No further business coming before council it adjourned.
