

Lebanon Aug 15th 1922

Council met in regular session

Mayor Byron Mullett presiding:

All the Councilmen present on roll call
Minutes of previous meeting read and approved
as read.

The Committee on Streets and Public Property
reported progress in the matter of Foot Bridge
across the Canal on Ash Street

The committee on Ways and Means reported
that the proposition to build an addition to
the Fire House, was dropped for the present:

The Committee appointed to urge the County
Commissioners to repair the break in the dam
at the Head Gates of the Canal, reported that the
condition of the River farther down stream
was the more serious menace to the City,
and the City Attorney was instructed to call
the attention of the County Court, to the danger
of the River making a new channel east of
the Bridge across the river:

The Report of the City Recorder for the 2nd Quarter
was read and on motion was accepted
and ordered placed on file:

A report of the condition of different sidewalks
and recommending repair and new sidewalks
was made by the Supt. of Streets; and

Resolution # 2 for 1922, ordering new sidewalks

and on Roll call was passed, all the members
of the Council voting yes:

An application by the Lebanon Mutual Telephone Co. for a franchise to erect poles string wires and cables and to operate in the City of Lebanon was read, and Ordinance bill #15 Feb 1922 a bill for an Ordinance granting a franchise to the Lebanon Mutual Telephone Co. was read the first time in full. on the question shall the bill be read the second time by title only; the roll was called and all the members of the Council voting yes, the title only of the bill was read.
