

Lebanon Ore Sept 5th 1922

Council met in regular session, with Mayor Byron Mullen, presiding. Councilmen present: J. M. Burtenshaw, B. L. Cotton, Elmer Fitzgibald, Frank Doolittle, L. E. Keyne. The report of the Fire Chief, and Committee on streets and Public Property, as to the condition of certain buildings, was read and ordered placed on file; a bill for an Ordinance, declaring certain buildings to be dangerous, and a Public Nuisance, and ordering the removal of the same, was read the first, second and third times in regular order, and passed, all the members of the Council, present voting yes, on the several roll calls; There being no objections, the title of the bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance:

Ordinance Bill # 15, as amended, granting a Franchise to the Lebanon Mutual Telephone Co., was read for the third time, and passed, all the members of the Council, present voting yes, on roll call; There being no objection the title of the bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance:

A motion was made and carried, that the City Attorney, take action to collect delinquent street assessments:

The City Marshall, was instructed, to notify Owners of the building, in which the Council chamber is located; to have Toilet cleaned up and keep the same in a sanitary condition, or to keep the same closed:

On motion the Lebanon, E. L. & Water Co. was instructed to repair the street paving, at the intersection of Main and Sherman Street at once; The matter of Water pressure, and condition of the Fire Hydrants, was discussed, and the Mayor appointed the Council, as a committee to prevail on the Owners of the Leb. E. L. & Water Co. and secure some measure, for the safety of the Public:

On motion the Leb. E. L. & Water Co. was instructed to install Hydrant, at 4th and Grant Streets as ordered on August 17th 1920; and also to standardize the Hydrants as required by their
