Council met in regular session

Mayor Chad Sterling presiding.

and all the Councilmen present on roll call.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. As read.

The Com on Streets and Public Property reported that they had the fence at the City Dump ground, cut down, and that the vision of train men, and of drivers on the County road, was no longer obstructed.

They also reported that the construction of the Dike South east of the City was progressing rapidly.

The report of the viewers: J C Irvine, Paul<sup>a</sup> Mitchell and S O Wallace, appointed by the Council on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 1923 to estimate the value of the land of the Simms Estate, proposed to be used in the construction of a dike, to prevent the flood waters of the Santiam River from entering the City, and placing the value of the land at \$100<sup>00</sup>; was read and placed on file.

The matter of Improving the Alley in Block No. 3, original Town of Lebanon, was referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property.

Ord Bill # 8. for 1923. a Bill for an Ordinance

Ord # 302. Appropriating the sum of One hundred dollars out of the <sup>City</sup> general fund for the purpose of being deposited with the County Clerk of Lincoln Co. Ore. in accordance with the report of the viewers, duly appointed by Ordinance # 300. of the City of Lebanon, was read the first, second, and third times in regular order, and passed, all the members of the Council voting yes on the several roll calls.

There being no objection the title of the bill was declared to be the Title of the Ordinance.

September 4<sup>th</sup> Continued.

On motion \$250<sup>00</sup> of the amount allowed in the Budget for 1923 for the Park Commission was transferred to the Contingent fund and \$200<sup>00</sup> transferred to the State Industrial Accident fund. Mr. Mayer of the Park Commission, having at a previous meeting informed the Council that the Park Commission should not use the money this year; and that it could be used for other purposes.
