Ord Bill # 15 for 1923. a bill for an Ordinance
authorizing and directing the Mayor and Recorder
to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of
Lebanon with the Western Bond and Mortgage Co
of Portland: to invest the Sewer Bond Sinkings
Fund of the City: was read the first time
and, there being no objection, on roll call, the
bill was read the second time by title only.
