A motion that the petition be granted was made

 and Supt of Streets, to furnish specifications  
 and estimate of probable cost of the improvement  
 of East Oak Street, was read and, on roll  
 call was adopted: all the members of the Council  
 voting yes:

Resolution # 7 for 1924, requesting the City Engineer  
 and Supt of Streets, to prepare specifications and  
 furnish an estimate of the probable cost of the  
 improvement of River Street, from the South  
 line of Grant Street to the North line of E. Oak St.,  
 was read and on roll call was passed, all the  
 members of the Council voting yes:

August 19<sup>th</sup> Continued  
 Resolution #8 for 1924, providing for the construction of Cement Sidewalks abutting Lot #1 Block #15, and Lot #8 Block #16 Relations addition to Lebanon, on Rose and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets and the East end of Lots #17 2, Block #10, original City of Lebanon; and adjoining Lot #8 Block #2 Lebanon addition to Lebanon, on the North side of Vine Street; was read, and on roll call was adopted, all members of the Council voting aye.

Communication from the State Ind Act Com. stating there should be a refund due the City; and desiring to know whether the City wanted Credit on future remittances, or cash. On motion the City Attorney was instructed to notify the Commission to send Cash.
