 from Grant St. to Oak Street, were read  
 and ordered placed on file:

 of River Street from Grant Street to Oak  
 Street: and authorizing the Supt of Streets  
 to make the improvement be prayed for  
 was read and adopted. on roll call, all  
 members of the Council voting yes:
