A Motion that. Here interfering with Side
walk, on Second Street between Pine and Ash
Street, be ordered removed: was carried:

Ord Bill #14: A bill for an Ordinance, amending Sections
Ord #318 No 1-17, and 18, of Ordinance #111, passed by
the Council on the 5th day of Dec 1911, being an
Ordinance to License Regulate, Tax and restrain certain
callings: was read the first, second
and third times in regular order, and
passed: all members of the Council voting
yes, on the several roll calls:
