

Lebanon Ore Nov 6th 1924

Council met in adjourned session
Mayor Thad Steedley presiding.

All the members of the Council being
present on roll call.

Minutes of previous meeting read, and
approved as read.

The committee on streets and Public property
reported that they had the Grant Street
bridge repaired, and had postponed re-decking
until some future time; and that a section
of the concrete paving next to the Bridge
had been replaced by new concrete.

The same committee in a written report
recommending the hiring of J. M. Doucass
as janitor for \$12.00 per month.

After discussion a motion was made and
carried, that the City Marshall be instructed
to employ Mrs McKinney, to clean the
City Hall when needed, at One Dollar per
cleaning.

On motion the City Attorney was instructed
to notify the General Manager of the Mt.
States Power Co. to have approach to Bridge
on Grove St. and the retaining wall at
Bridge on Main Street constructed at once:
