The matter of investigating the possibility of
paving North and South Main Street
was referred to the committee on Ways
and Means:

The City Attorney reported, that the connection
of side walk with the Bridge on Cross St.
had been constructed: and that some work
was being done on the retaining wall, at
the Bridge across the Canal on main St:
and that he had no information as yet in regard
to vacant house on Cross Street north of Wheeler St:

for 1924 a bill for an Ordinance, authorizing
the payment of \$197.⁴⁰ to C. E. Davis for
repair of the paved streets, warrant to be
drawn against the Dike + Improvement fund
for the amount: was read the first, second
and third times in regular order, and passed
all members of the Council, voting yea, on
the several roll calls:

There being no objections the title of the bill,
was declared to be the title of the Ordinance:
motion made and carried that the Street Commission
be authorized to construct a concrete culvert
across South Main Street at or near the
intersection of Milton Street:
