

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TENTATIVE CITY BUDGET

Notice is hereby given that a public meeting will be held in the City Hall in Lebanon, Oregon, on Monday November 20th, 1922, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p. m. of said day for the purpose of discussing and considering the budget submitted by the budget Committee of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for the fiscal year of 1923m beginning with the first day of January 1923 and ending with the 31st day of December 1923, at which time and place any legal voter of the said city may be heard for or against the said budget or any part thereof. The total amount of money needed by the said city for the various offices and departments and works and improvements and other purposes of the said City for the said year and including amounts received from all sources and by direct taxation against all the taxable property in the said city is as follows as given in the said tentative budget. NOTICE OF TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON, IN  
LINN COUNTY, OREGON FOR FISCAL YEAR 1923.

TO THE ASSESSOR OF LINN COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, AND  
TO THE COUNTY CLERK OF LINN COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON.

YOU AND EACH OF YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, That at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, duly held in the City Hall in said City of the 21st day of November, 1922, that the said Council duly adopted and passed a resolution adopting a budget of expenditures of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, for the Year 1923, and that prior to said action adopting the said budget, the said Council duly appointed a budget committee as by law required, and had given all notices required by law, and a public meeting and hearing was had on the said budget where any legal voter of the said city was given an opportunity to be heard for or against the said budget or any item thereof, and that the said hearing the said proposed expenditures were all approved and ratified, That the said Council by said resolution duly levied the following sums to be raised by the said city for the said year 1923. and that the said budget so adopted and approved calls for the total expenditure for the said year 1923, the total sum of \$22,463.25

That the estimated revenues of the said city to be received from all other sources other than direct taxation is the sum of

\$ 563.25

And that the total amount of money levied and to be raised by direct taxation against all the taxable property of the said city for the said year in the sum of \$21,900.00

and the said council by reas resolution levied and appropriated said sum for the said year.

that the fiscal year for the said city begins January 1st, 1923 and ends december 31, 1923.

That the said sums are within six per cent increase over the sums raised by direct taxation for the year 1922, in said city.

This notice is given by Order of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon Oregon, duly made by resolution duly adopted at said meeting on November 21, 1922.
