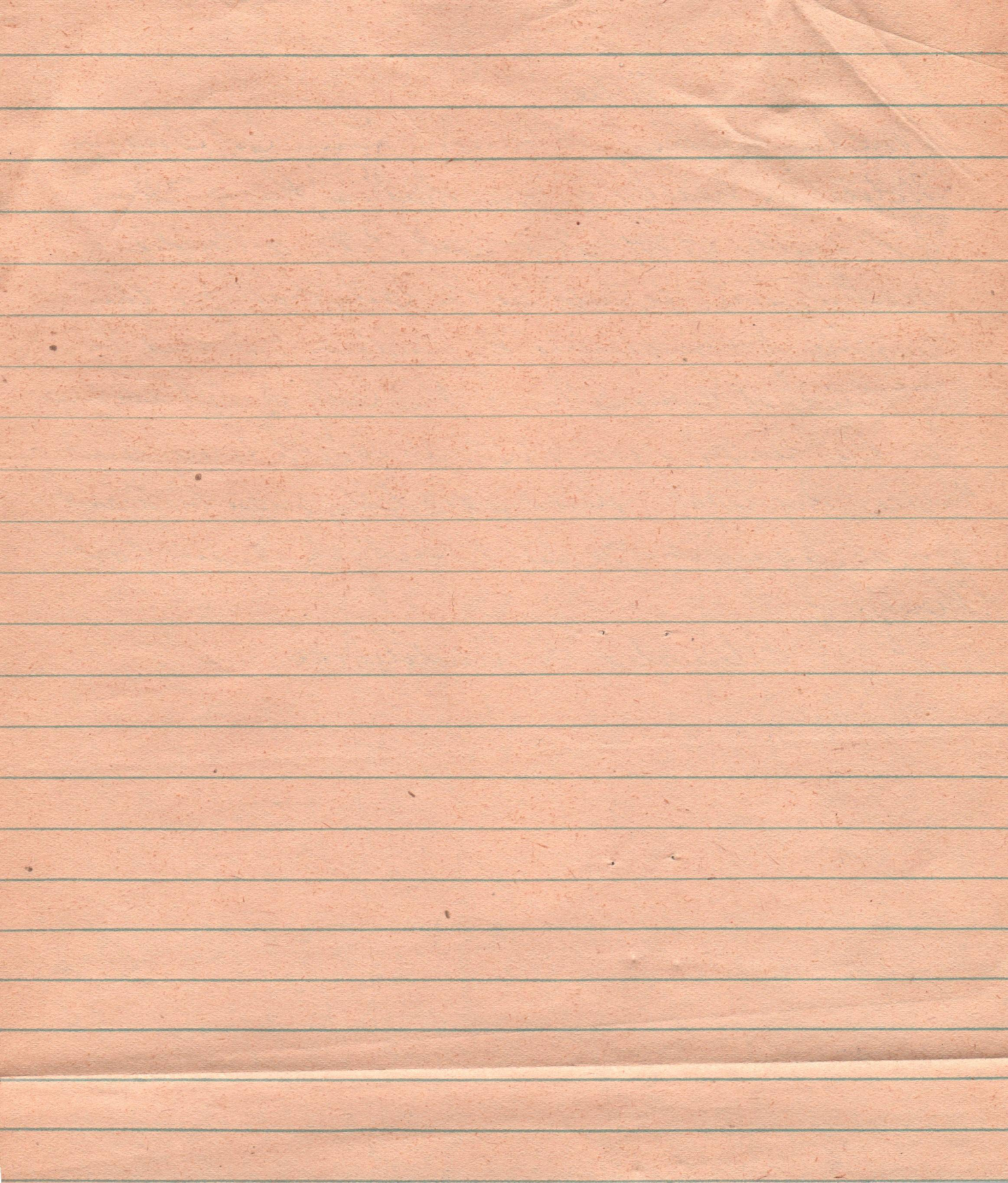


## Notice
