To the Honorable Mayor and Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon:

Having been duly appointed to audit the books of the Treasurer and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, I beg to report as follows, having made a complete audit for the year beginning August 1, 1919, and ending Dec. 31, 1919; for the year 1920; for the year 1921; for the year 1922; for the term beginning Jan. 1, 1923 and ending Feb. 22, 1923; and for the term beginning Feb. 23, 1923 and ending Dec. 31, 1923, making 6 separate statements to cover same.

The complete report is appended hereto, and I have tried to gover everything necessary to show the results. The following pages are an outline of the complete report.

In going through the Treasurer's books, I have found a great many errors, especially in entering the amounts in the wrong accounts, and the only conclusion I could arrive at was to take the accounts as they show in his books, and the report is made accordingly. The Recorder's books show more accurately the receipts in the different Bonded and General Funds, and I have a schedule showing the differences and the reconcilliations of the two books.

On account of the books not bein Audited for a term of five years, there are certain things which could have been corrected and the balances carried forward each year corrected, instead of the old errors carried forward year after year. I am surely convinced that the books should be audited perhaps every year, but certainly not let over two years pass without an audit. The books in Albany, I find are audited every two years, which seems to meet requirements there, but believe a yearly audit the best.

Our system of keeping the receipts is a very poor one, and I would recommend that the Accounts Committeebe authorized to have installed a more up to date book for the Recorder to use, so as to have the accounts of the City easier to keep and a great deal more satisfactory both to the pecorder and the city. We have Seven (7) receipt books for the Treasurer, one for each separate Fund as to Sinking Bond Improvement, making five, and one for each General Fund, two. In my opinion. ONE Receipt book is all that is necessary and will simplify matters a great deal, as there is always danger of getting the funds mixed in the different books, and that happened a good many times during this audit. I suggest that the present receipt books be discarded (that is the ones outside of the General) and only one form be used for all receipts coming in to the Treasurer .. The Treasurer has not been giving the Recorder any record of Moneys received from the Taxes, and this should be done the same as for any other moneys received so that the Recorder will have his records the same as the Treasurer. The receipts should be numbered, and none of them destroyed, but if one is spoiled, be marked "VOID" thus every receipt will be accounted for and the danger of mistakes lessened.

In checking over, I find that on Aug: 21, 1920, the City borrowed from the First National Bank for General Fund Purposes the amount of \$1000.00 at the same time having on deposit at the two Banks a balance of \$7151.34, and paid \$11.61 unnecessary Interest.

I also find that Some Warrants #1834, 1855, 1873, 1874, 1875, 1881, 1886, 1887, 1896, 1897, 1902, 1904, 1906 and 1909, were presented for payment at the Lebanon National pank during July, August and Sept., 1920, andorsed "Not Paid for want of Funds", and drew Interest till June 18, 1921: Also Warrants #1949, 1957, 1976, 1978, 1981, 1987, 1992, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2014, 2016, 2018, 2019 were presented for payment duringNov. and Dec, 1920, and Jan. 1921 at the Lebanon National Bank, endorsed "Not paid for want of Funds" and drew Interest till Sept. 26, 1921. During all this time there was on Afficial.

On Feb. 22, 1923, the report shows a balance due Cruson as Treasurer of \$450.77, the same errors being carried forward, which with some additional errors make the difference as shown.

From Feb. 23, 1923 to the end of the year, all the errors that were made were in posting to the wrong fund, so there were no additional errors, and the balance due Cruson is still \$450.77. I would recommend that the same be paid as soon as convenient.

In the term from August 1, 1919 to the present Audit, as of Dec. 31, 1923, I have listed amounts received by Recorder which were not receipted for By the Treasurer, the amount being \$138.17, which amount is due the City. This would not have occurred had the books of the Treasurer and Recorder been compared, and I cannot urge too strongly that this be done every quarter before the reports are made out. Would suggest this matter be turned over to the Accounts committee for adjustment.

In the Statement of Warrants drawn and paid I find a few minor differences as to the amount of the Bill against the City and the Warrant drawn for same, but these are so small as to be almost negligible. The amount of outstanding Warrants at the beginning of be the term was as near as we can determine, \$96.00 and at the end of the term, Dec. 31, 1923, General Fund, \$902.03; Dike Fund, \$116.73, a total of \$1018.76, which are all taken up at the present time.

I had great difficulty in making part of this Audit as the Bank Statements and Checks drawn by Treasurer Cruson have been distroyed, and I had to work from almost nothing in some cases. I think everything should be paid by Check, even amounts due the city from the City, as it makes a double Check on all items, both through the Treasurer's books and through the Banks.

I found one coupon on the City of LaGrande that was paid by Treas. Cruson, and while it is only a small amount, believe everything should be checked over before a check is given the Bank for the Coupons they deliver to the Treasurer, and have urged and in-

never less than \$5000.00 and from that up to \$15.000.00. During this time the City paid Interest on these two bunches of Warrants in the amount of \$103.07, which was entirely unnecessary, making a total of Interest paid unnecessarily of \$114.68. Had the Treasurer made a Quarterly Report, and the same been compared with the report of the Recorder, this need not have occurred, and I believe the Finance Committee should insist that the Treasurer report Quarterly as does the Recorder, and that their reports be reconciled before they are submitted to the Council.

At the end of 1919, the report shows a balance due Treas.

Cruson of \$60.64, errors in entry occurring in the General, Interest,

Main Street and Grant Street Funds.

At the end of 1920, the report shows as balance due Treas. Cruson of \$1239.44, errors occurring in the General, Interest,
Main Street, Sherman Street, Grant Street, and Refunding Bond Sinking
Funds, the largest error being the entry of \$1000.00 in the Refunding Bond Sinking Fund, this being entered as received from the Co.
Treasurer, when it should have been transferred from the General Fund.

At the end of 1921, the report shows a balance due Treas.

Crison of \$1906.24, the same errors being carried forward, together with an entry in pencil marked "Error" \$602.37 in General nFund.

At the end of 1922, the report shows a balance due Treas. Cruson of only \$302.00, the errors being carried forward as a matter of course, but reduced by the entry in both General and Sinking Funds of a payment of \$1500.00. In 1920 there was also a pencil entry of "Error" 1217.44, payment of Bonds 9 \$ 10 Sherman Street, \$1000.00 and a payment of Interest out of both General and Interest Funds of \$500.00, Errors in having entered Deposit Slips as well as Receipts of \$494.95 and not entered at all, \$162.50. besides there were numer erous other small errors, all of which are listed in the body of the Report. 1920 was the worst year of all as regards Errors.




