I have carefully audited the books of the Recorder and of the Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, checked all entries and verified all receipts and disbursements, and have made the following corrections:

CITY RECORDER'S BOOK

Page #18 - Bonded Streets, Main Street from Carolina Street North to City Limits; error of \$10.07 in addition. Page #19 - Bonded Streets - Second Street from Grant St. North to Tangent Street; error of \$10.36 due to duplicate entry, this amount having also been entered on Page #18. Page #22 - Street Improvement Bond Interest Fund - corrected balances transferred from Pages #18 and #19 due to errors listed above, which also changed balance in this account from \$269.62 to \$269.33.
