During the year 1936 the total receipts from all sources amounted to \$51,105.25. These receipts were checked and found to be all properly accounted for. The amounts received from the County Treasurer and from the County Road Fund were verified by direct correspondence with the County Treasurer and County Clerk respectively. The amounts received in interest and street assessments are evidenced by receipts issued to the person making the payment. These receipts were checked with the lien docket register and also traced to deposit in the bank. These receipts were found to be correct and properly entered with the exception of a few minor clerical errors which were corrected.

The total disbursements during the year were \$40,254.20. The vouchers for these expenditures were examined and found to be proper and regular. The authority for the issuance of these vouchers was not checked but it was assumed that proper authorization appears in the minutes of the Council.

As at December 31, 1936 the bonded indebtedness of the City of Lebanon was \$26,000.00 distributed as follows:

Interest paid in 1936 amounted to \$ 1,160.00. Coupons covering these payments were checked and found to be on hand properly canceled.

The amount of cash on hand was verified by the depository due reconciliation having been made with the books of account. The distribution of the cash among the various funds is shown in Schedule II of this report.

Unpaid liens against local property as of the date of the audit amounted to \$4,470.29 exclusive of accrued interest as shown by the lien docket register.

No check was made as to the real property owned by the City.
