VACATIONS

Dr. Rice reported that a question had been raised by the Council regarding Library vacations. It was agreed that the City Employees Handbook was to be used as a standard.

BUDGET

The coming budget was discussed with the decision to request added personnel this year. The total estimated budget was \$30,718. This included a \$2000 allowance for major replacements for repairs -- as the Board had studied the main Library with a tentative plan to move the desk, put in another table and some shorter stocks.

NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK

Mr. Jensen reported that he had discussed with the newspaper a plan for plugging National Library Week. Mrs. Reed reported she had requested Judge Hunt to appoint a County Advisor to help the Board plan for more adequate service to the branches and stations. Miss Gilbert reported her attendance at the State Library Workshop March 7 & 8th - she will report further later.
