There was a discussion of the possibility of having a Bookmobile. Mr. Jensen suggested that a panel truck might be purchased and that the firemen make shelves, etc. for it. Mrs. Stadelmen said she would bring information about a new Bookmobile at the next meeting.

The furnace should be cleaned. Permission granted.

The magazines are renewable next month. McGregor Co. has been chosen for the renewals, as the other company gave considerable trouble.

A new Encyclopedia Britannica has been ordered. We will pay one-half this year on it, and one-half next year.
