**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 a.m. by Don Hall, at the Tapadera Restaurant, 112 W Second Street, The Dalles, Oregon.

**ROLL CALL**

Present: Don Hall, Cecelia Cushing, Maury Snow, Becky Ohmart, Frank Bonn and Mark Sullivan.

Absent: None.

Vacancy: One vacancy.

Council Present: Merritt Probstfield.

**MINUTES - DECEMBER 20, 1989**

A motion was made by Maury Snow and seconded by Cecelia Cushing to approve the minutes of December 20, 1989, as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Review: One Way (westbound) Parking on 5th Street Between Washington and Union Streets: Information regarding number of existing spaces, number of proposed spaces, angle parking, etc. was provided by Operations Director Jerry Betts. The Commission discussed the proposal. It was noted there would be a loss of two spaces with diagonal parking. It was moved by Frank Bonn and seconded by Becky Ohmart to deny the request for one way (westbound) parking on 5th Street between Washington and Union Streets. The motion carried unanimously.

Vision Problem at N.E. Corner of Jefferson Street and Scenic Drive: The Commission asked if a letter was sent to the Fire Department requesting them to investigate the vision problem created by trees and shrubbery. It was determined no letter was sent. The Commission asked Don Hall and Frank Bonn to draft a

letter. They will speak to the City Clerk if assistance is needed and Hall and Bonn will ensure the letter is delivered to the Fire Department.

Stop Signs at N.W. Corner of 12th Street and Shearer Street, 12th Street and Roberts Street and the N.W. and S.E. corners of 12th Street and "J" Street: Operations Director Jerry Betts commented the stop signs were installed at the above mentioned locations yesterday.

Safety Belt Initiative: Chairman Don Hall reviewed a letter received from Helen Liere, Coordinator - Community Traffic Safety Program. The Commission discussed the encouragement and endorsement of the initiative.

Review of Proposed Skate Board Ordinance: The Commission discussed the Skateboard issue. There will be a Skateboard Community Action Planning meeting in the near future. The Commission asked Cecelia Cushing to attend the meeting as a Traffic Safety Commission representative. She agreed to attend the meeting on behalf of the Commission.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Review of East 19th Street Proposal: Chairman Don Hall explained the City's proposal to complete improvements on a section of 19th Street, near the hospital. The Commission discussed the proposal. No recommendation was made at this time.

**MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS**

Jerry Betts explained to the Commission an address/street signage problem on 15th Street between "G" and "H" Streets. He asked the Commission to look at this situation and provide comments at the next Traffic Safety Commission meeting.

**ADJOURNMENT**

A motion was made by Frank Bonn and seconded by Maury Snow to adjourn this meeting. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 a.m.
