





Even though I won't be at the meeting, there is an item that I think you might want to address. On Thursday the 12th, at about 7:15 am City Public Works was cleaning off the 6th street Mill Creek bridge with a grader... 6th St. traffic was blocked in both directions. I had approached from the south coming down Trevitt and I was flagged to circle back. There was no notification of a detour and no signage. I saw only one "flagger" that had a red topped signaling flashlight and the detour route being pointed out by that flagger was up Trevitt Street. I don't know what was being done on the west side of the bridge. I understand that the crews are stretched thin and that there is much to do. With that in mind it still created an unsafe situation at a bad time of the morning. If it had been done at 4:00 am it might not have mattered and while 7:15 am is better than 8:00am, cleaning that bridge really requires more of what the City crew usually does so well- proper planning and execution. So my input is to do this job a little earlier in the day and eliminate the risk of having to re-route increasing amounts of traffic (especially up hill) at a spot that is already a significant bottle-neck. (I'm not picking on you or your guys, Bill... I just suggest that it should be done differently next time)
