# A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE FEES FOR SWIM LESSON SERVICES AT THE MOLALLA AQUATIC CENTER

- WHEREAS: The City of Molalla Aquatic Center has operated as an American Red Cross pool since the facility opened; and
- WHEREAS: All of the current swim lesson instructors are certified through the American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor and Fundamentals of Instructor Training courses; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross has notified the City that it will begin charging \$5.00 per lesson for each swim lesson attendee; and
- WHEREAS: The Molalla City Council, during its December 14, 2011 regularly scheduled session approved a motion to increase the swim lesson fees to enable the City to continue to provide lessons through the American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim Program and bring fees more in line with neighboring pools; and
- WHEREAS: It is in the public interest to continue to offer American Red Cross certified swimming lessons.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MOLALLA RESOLVES as follows:

- 1. The fee for a regular session in-district attendee is to be increased from \$28.00 per session to \$38.00 per session.
- 2. The fee for regular session out-of-district attendee is to be increased from \$38.00 per session to \$50.00 per session.
- 3. This fee change is to become effective January 25, 2012.

**Background:** The City has been operating as an American Red Cross pool since the facility opened. All of the current lesson teachers are certified through the American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor and Fundamentals of Instructor Training courses. The American Red Cross will begin to charge \$5.00 per child in every swimming lesson. The matter was presented to Council during the December 14, 2011 Regular Session Council meeting. At that meeting, the City Council approved by motion to increase the swim lesson fees to enable the City to continue proving swim lessons through the American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim Program and to bring fees more in line with neighboring pools.
