Transferring \$ 100,000 from Personnel Services to Materials and Services is necessary to provide appropriation to provide coverage of management and emergency communication services for the dispatch center as identified in the Intergovernmental Agreement with Seaside and personal service contract for management transition with Jeff Rusiecki. Sufficient funds are available in the Personnel Services category due to the vacancies of Emergency Communications Manager and dispatch staff.

The total requirements remain the same for this fund.
