

**RESOLUTION No. 2598**

**AMENDING RATES AND SCHEDULES TO THE SPRING CLEAN-UP COLLECTION POLICY AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 2072**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Warrenton has found that Spring Clean-Up Day is a benefit of the citizens of Warrenton, and;

**WHEREAS**, the success of Spring Clean-Up Day has continued to be a popular event with widespread participation, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has found it necessary to adopt a formal Spring Clean-Up Day collection policy as a means of controlling the cost to Warrenton's rate payers.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** Spring Clean-Up Day will be a one-day event held on a weekend day.

**SECTION 2:** Participants will be required to show that they are a City of Warrenton garbage ratepayers in the City of Warrenton by showing a current City utility bill in the name of the participant.

**SECTION 3:** The City will collect \$5.00 per vehicle and/or trailer load to offset the costs of Spring Clean-Up Day to the ratepayers of Warrenton.

**SECTION 4:** The City retains the ability to collect additional fees for items that impose extra cost on the City as a result of their disposal and sets new rates for the following items.

Tires Off Rim	\$ 3.00	Tires On Rim	\$ 6.00
Refrigerator/Freezers	\$ 35.00	Large Appliances	\$ 8.00


**SECTION 5:** The City maintains the right to reject any materials deemed inappropriate or hazardous.
