### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Effective Tuesday, March 17, in response to Governor Brown's Executive Order which is effective at 2pm today, limiting the number of people at a gathering to 25 people, the City of The Dalles is taking steps to help slow the transmission of the coronavirus and ensure the safety of our community.

**All** non-essential meetings have been cancelled through April 17. This includes all City Council and Commission/Committee Meetings. In the event that essential meetings are required, methods of public access will be announced that may include audio and live-streaming video access.

All City office lobbies have been closed to the public. Staff is available by phone and the City Hall drop box located on Third Street next to the parking lot may be used to transmit documents.
