

**RESOLUTION NO. P.C. 199-92 APPROVING SITE PLAN
REVIEW NO. 135-92 OF JACK'S MINI MARKET TO INSTALL
SERVICE STATION ISLANDS AND CANOPY
WITH UNDERGROUND GAS TANKS**

I. RECITALS:

- A. The Planning Commission of the City of The Dalles has, on this day, conducted a public hearing to consider the above request for use of property described as:

3213 NE Frontage Road, described as Township 1 North, Range 13 East, Section 1, Tax Lot 202.
- B. A staff report was presented, stating the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and a staff recommendation.
- C. Staff Report No. SPR 135-92 and the minutes of February 6, 1992, upon approval, provide the basis for this resolution and are herein attached by reference.

II. RESOLUTION: Now, therefore, be it FOUND, DETERMINED, and RESOLVED by the Planning Commission of the City of The Dalles as follows:


- A. In all respects as set forth in Recitals, Part "I" of this resolution,
- B. Site Plan Review 135-92 is hereby approved with the following conditions:
 - 1. The parking lot must be designed according to the provisions of Section 27, "Off-Street Parking".
 - 2. All signs must meet the sign ordinance requirements and be permitted by the Planning Department.
 - 3. All future lighting shall be arranged to direct light away from adjacent properties.
 - 4. All federal, state, and local regulations shall be researched by the applicant and proof of compliance with D.E.Q. and E.P.A. standards in placement and monitoring of the underground fuel tanks shall be provided to the Planning Department prior to issuance of a building permit.
 - 5. All City Fire and Utility Department standards shall be met, including issuance of a fire prevention permit and a utility cross-connection inspection.

III. APPEALS, COMPLIANCE, AND PENALTIES

- A. Any party of record may appeal a decision of the Planning Commission to the City Council for review. Appeals must be made according to Section 36 of the Zoning Ordinance, and must be filed with City Clerk with in ten (10) days of the date of resolution.
- B. Failure to exercise this approval within the time limits set either by resolution or by ordinance will invalidate this permit.
- C. All conditions of approval must be met within the time limits set by this resolution or by ordinance. Failure to meet any condition will prompt enforcement proceedings that can result in: 1) permit revocation; 2) fines of up to \$2,500 per day for the violation period and/or imprisonment in the County jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year.

The Secretary of the Commission shall (a) certify to the adoption of the Resolution; (b) forthwith transmit a copy of said Resolution to City Council of the City of The Dalles; (c) transmit a copy of the Resolution along with a stamped approved/denied site plan or plat to the applicant.
