

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-001**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET  
FOR THE COLUMBIA GATEWAY URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY,  
MAKING ALLOCATIONS, AND CERTIFYING A REQUEST FOR  
MAXIMUM TAX REVENUE TO THE COUNTY ASSESSOR.**

**WHEREAS**, the Urban Renewal Budget Committee, on April 13, 2021, solicited public comment on the proposed budget and approved a balanced budget for FY21/22; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with State Law, the Urban Renewal Board of Directors held a Public Hearing on the approved budget on May 18, 2021; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COLUMBIA GATEWAY URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Adoption of the Budget for FY21/22.**

The Board of Directors of the Columbia Gateway Urban Renewal Agency hereby adopts the budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the total of **\$6,238,360**, now on file in the office of the City Finance Director.

The amounts for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and for the purposes shown below are hereby appropriated:
