5	WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of The Dalles, Oregon,
6	and five (5) appointed City residents, pursuant to the provisions
7	of Chapter 457 of the Oregon Revised Statutes, and City Ordinance
8	No. 90-1106, are the duly appointed Urban Renewal Agency of the
9	City of The Dalles, Oregon.
10	WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to adopt a set of by-laws to
11	govern the conduct and business of the Agency.
	NOW, THEREFORE, the Columbia Gateway Urban Renewal Agency of
13	the City of The Dalles does resolve as follows:
14	ARTICLE I - AUTHORITY
15	Section 1. Name: The name of the Agency shall be the
16	Columbia Gateway Urban Renewal Agency of the City of The Dalles,

Oregon, hereinafter referred to as "Agency".

Section 2.

Section 3. <u>Power and Duties of the Agency</u>: The powers and duties of the Agency shall be as provided by Chapter 457 of the Oregon Revised Statutes, The Dalles City Charter, and as authorized by the City Council of The Dalles in accordance with

The office of the Agency shall be the

Ordinance No. 90-1106, adopted by The Dalles City Council on April 23, 1990.

ARTICLE II - AGENCY

Section 1. Agency Membership: The Agency membership shall consist of eleven (11) members, including the five (5) elected members of The Dalles City Council and the mayor plus five (5) non-council residents of the City of The Dalles.

Pursuant to ORS 457.035, the Agency is " ... a public body, corporate and politic ...".

Section 2. <u>Agency Terms</u>: The term of office of each Agency member shall be as follows:

- (a) The terms of the five (5) members of The Dalles City Council and the Mayor, shall be concurrent with each member's term of office as a member of the City Council;
- (b) The non-council/non-mayor positions shall be numbered and terms of office shall be four (4) years. The terms of office of the five (5) appointed residents may, at the discretion of the City Council, be extended to a second term of four (4) years. Upon such member completing his or her appointed term(s) the City Council of The Dalles shall appoint a replacement member. Members may be reappointed at the discretion of the City Council. Provided, however, that a prior

member, whose term(s) has expired, may also be considered for such replacement membership.

3 ARTICLE III - OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers: The officers of the Agency shall be chair, vice chair, and any other officer whom the Agency deems necessary.

Section 2. Chair: The Chair shall be elected by the Agency members and shall preside at all meetings of the Agency. Except as otherwise authorized by resolution of the Agency, the Chair shall sign all contracts, deeds and other instruments made by the Agency. At each Agency meeting, the Chair shall submit such information and recommendations as the Chair may consider proper concerning the business, affairs and policies of the Agency.

Section 3. <u>Vice Chair</u>: The Vice Chair shall be elected by the Agency and shall perform the duties of the Chair in the absence or incapacity of the Chair; and in case of resignation or death of the Chair, the Vice Chair shall perform such duties as are imposed on the Chair until such time as the Agency shall elect a new Chair.

Section 4. Additional Duties: The officers of the Agency shall perform such other duties and functions as may from time to time be required by the Agency or by the by-laws or rules and regulations of the Agency.

Section 5. <u>Election or Appointment</u>: The officers of the Agency shall be elected annually by the Agency from among the Agency members at the first regular meeting of the Agency in January of each year, and shall hold office for one (1) year or until their successors are elected and qualified. Provided, however, that the interim officers initially elected shall hold office until the first regular meeting of the Agency in 1992, or until their successors are elected and qualified.

Section 6. <u>Vacancies</u>: Should the offices of the Chair, or Vice Chair or other Agency office become vacant, the Agency shall elect a successor from its Agency members at the next regular meeting and such election shall be for the unexpired term of such office. Should any other member's term be vacated for any reason, The Dalles City Council shall appoint a replacement member for the unexpired term of such vacated position. The replacement member shall be a resident of the City of The Dalles.

Section 7. Removal: The Chair, or any other officer may be removed from that office at any time by a vote of a majority of the entire Agency.

Section 8. <u>Personnel</u>: The Agency may create such positions and appoint such personnel as it may from time to time find necessary or convenient to perform its duties and obligations at such compensation as may be established by the Agency. Such appointments shall continue at the pleasure of the Agency or until resignation. The Agency may contract with the City of The

Dalles for the services of City personnel at such terms and conditions as the Agency and the City Council may agree.

## ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular Meetings: Regular meetings shall be held each month at such time and place as may from time to time be determined by resolution of the Agency in conformance with Oregon Public Meetings Law. A regular meeting may be continued, postponed, cancelled or adjourned to a later date by a vote of the majority of the Agency members present and voting, and notice of such adjourned meeting shall be given to all Agency members.

Section 2. Special Meetings: The Chair may, when the Chair deems it expedient, and shall, upon the written request of five (5) Agency members, call a special meeting of the Agency to be held at the regular meeting place, unless otherwise specified in the call, for the purpose of transacting any business designated. Notice shall be given to the public in accordance with the Oregon Public Meetings Law. Members shall be notified by telephone at least twenty-four (24) hours before a special meeting. A reasonable attempt to reach the member is sufficient notice, even if actual contact is not made. Presence of any Agency member at any meeting shall be deemed to be a waiver of notice of such meeting. Special meetings may also be held at any time by the unanimous consent of all Agency members.

Section 3. Quorum: A majority of the incumbent members of the Agency shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of

conducting its business and exercising its powers and for all other purposes. Six concurring votes shall be necessary to decide any question before the Agency.

Section 4. Manner of Voting: The voting shall be by roll call, and the ayes and nays and Agency members abstaining shall be entered upon the minutes of such meeting. The reasons for any abstention shall be relected in the minutes.

Section 5. <u>Resolutions</u>: All resolutions shall be in writing.

Section 6. <u>Roberts' Rules</u>: All rules of order not herein provided for shall be determined in accordance with "Roberts' Rules of Order - Newly Revised".

Section 7. Open Meetings: All meetings shall be open to the public, except that any portion of a meeting may be held in Executive Session if such session is in conformance with the Oregon Public Meetings Law.

## ARTICLE V - PROCEDURES

Section 1. <u>Standing or Special Committees</u>: The establishment of committees shall be by vote of the Agency. The Agency by vote may refer items to standing or special committees for report and recommendation. All committee members shall be appointed by the Chair, subject to approval by the Agency. The committee member first named shall act as Chair thereof. All committees need not be restricted to Agency members.

Section 2. <u>Authorization of Expenditures</u>: Authorization and approval of the expenditures of money may be made only at a regular meeting or at a special meeting called for that purpose. Provided, that no authorization or approval of expenditures of money may be made at a special meeting unless all Agency members have been advised in advance of said meeting that such authorizing action is intended to be taken or considered.

## ARTICLE VI - FINANCIAL

Section 1. <u>Custody of Funds</u>: The Finance Director of the City of The Dalles shall be the ex officio custodian of the funds of the Agency. Such funds shall be kept separate from the funds of the City. Investment and disbursement of Agency funds shall follow the regular investment and disbursement procedures of the City of The Dalles by the City Council. Upon approval of an Agency Budget prepared in accordance with Oregon Budget Laws, an Agency General Fund will be established. Other funds shall be established as needed by resolution of the Agency in accordance with Oregon State Law.

Section 2. <u>Budget</u>: Budget procedures followed for funds of the City of The Dalles shall also be substantially followed for the fund or funds of the Agency. The Budget Committee which reviews the budget of the Agency shall consist of twenty-two (22) members, the eleven (11) Agency members, both elected and appointed, plus eleven (11) members appointed by the Agency from residents of the City of The Dalles.

Section 3. Audit: An annual audit of the fund or funds
of the Agency shall be performed by the auditor of the City of
The Dalles using the same procedures as are used for funds of the
City.
ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS
Amendments to By-Laws: The by-laws of the Agency shall be
amended only with the approval of at least six (6) of the Agency
members at a regular or special meeting, but no such amendment
shall be adopted unless at least five (5) days written notice
thereof has been previously given to all of the Agency Members.
