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5 WHEREAS, the Columbia Gateway Urban Renewal Agency formally adopted By-Laws on February 5, 1991; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 1 requires a vote of the majority of the Agency to continue, postpone, cancel, or adjourn a meeting; 9 and WHEREAS, the members of the Agency have reconsidered the 10 language in Article IV, Section 1, of the By-Laws; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the members of the Agency have determined that the 13 chairman of the Agency should be given the authority to cancel a meeting, with a week's notice, when there is insufficient business 14 to justify holding the meeting. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Article IV, Section 16 17 1 shall be amended to read as follows: 18 Regular meetings shall be scheduled each month at such 19 time and place as may from time to time be determined by

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resolution of the Agency in conformance with Oregon Public Meeting Law. A regular meeting may be cancelled by the Chair, upon one week's notice to the Agency members, the news media, and the general public, if the chair determines, in the exercise of sound discretion, that there is insufficient business to justify the holding of a regular meeting. A regular meeting may be continued, postponed, cancelled or adjourned to a later date by a vote of the majority of the Agency members 10 present and voting, and notice of such adjourned meeting 11 shall be given to all Agency members.
