RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 18

WHEREAS, Chapter VII, Section 33 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon requires that an elected office shall be deemed vacant upon the incumbent's resignation; and

WHEREAS, at the July 14, 2021 City Council Meeting City Councilor Rebecca Grizzle announced her desire to resign as soon as a replacement could be appointed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to conduct interviews for a replacement at the September 8, 2021 City Council Meeting, with a swearing in at the October 13, 2021 meeting; and

WHEREAS, City Councilor Rebecca Grizzle's term does not expire until December 31, 2024.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lebanon:

Section 1. The City Council seat of Rebecca Grizzle, Ward 2, is hereby declared vacant effective October 12, 2021 and shall be filled through appointment by a majority of the incumbent members of the Council.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and Approved by the Mayor on the 11th day of August 2021 by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against.
