The Irisbus representatives used a PowerPoint presentation to describe the features of the CiViS bus being manufactured in France, as well as several bus rapid transit projects in Europe and the United States that would use buses manufactured by their company. They also showed a brief video of a prototype CiViS bus on a test guideway in France. Following the presentation, the Irisbus representatives answered questions on bus specifications from the audience. The special meeting ended after the question and answer period, at 5:25 p.m.
