

RESOLUTION NO. 2518

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING RESOLUTION NO. 2288 RELATING TO LIMITING COUNCIL MEETINGS TO 2 ½ HOURS UNLESS A MAJORITY VOTE OF COUNCIL EXTENDS

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That on May 26th, 2015 the City Council passed Resolution 2288 to limit Council Meetings and Work Sessions to 2 and ½ hours unless extended for 30 minutes at a time by a majority vote of Council.
2. That the City Council, on October 27th, 2020 passed an Ordinance amending Troutdale Municipal Code 2.08 regarding the conduct of Regular Council Meetings and Council Work Sessions.
3. That the beneficial impact of Resolution 2288 has been minimal or nonexistent.
4. That the City Council is operating much more harmonious than in the past, and with the adoption of the new ordinance, there is no reason to continue Resolution 2288 in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. That in accordance with the findings set forth above, the City Council hereby terminates Resolution 2288, and it shall have no further force or effect.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
