

RESOLUTION NO. 2522

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NEW SDIC AND NORTH TROUTDALE DRAINAGE MASTER PLAN

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The existing North Troutdale Storm Drainage Master Plan was adopted in 2007 by Resolution 1868
2. Since 2007, changes in the basin, including extensive and large-scale development, have rendered the 2007 master plan out of date.
3. As the City and Sandy Drainage Improvement Company (SDIC) provide complementary and interconnected drainage systems within the North Troutdale basin, it is prudent to plan for drainage infrastructure in a coordinated and collaborative manner.
4. The City and SDIC partnered to retain the services of the Brown and Caldwell engineering consulting firm to prepare a new Drainage Master Plan for the North Troutdale Basin.
5. The new Drainage Master Plan is complete and has been delivered to the City and SDIC.
6. This Drainage Master plan is adopted only as a sound technical assessment and guiding document providing recommendations for the current and future primary public drainage infrastructure needs in the basin but does not obligate the Council to implement or fund any recommended actions in the plan.
7. The addition of any recommended project to the City's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), or removal therefrom, remain the purview of the Council to be determined in future CIP updates, and funding of such projects remains the prerogative of the City Council and Budget Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The SDIC and North Troutdale Drainage Master Plan, prepared by Brown and Caldwell and dated November 12, 2020, is adopted.


