

RESOLUTION NO. 2527

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NEW CITY OF TROUTDALE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES (ADA) SELF-EVALUATION AND TRANSITION PLAN

TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Department of Justice title II regulations of the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) establishes the regulations relating to nondiscrimination on the basis of disability in State and local government services. The legislation requires public entities to identify and evaluate all programs, activities, and services, and to modify practices that are potentially discriminatory.
2. Under title II of the ADA, public entities are responsible for the provision of accessible programs and facilities that are available to all without discrimination toward people with disabilities.
3. To advance the Public Works Department's (PWD) ongoing efforts in meeting its responsibilities under title II of the ADA, the City commissioned the preparation of a new City of Troutdale Public Works Department ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan.
4. The City of Troutdale Public Works Department ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan was prepared and completed by MIG, Inc., a consulting firm with specialized knowledge, expertise, and experience in the ADA, self-evaluations, and preparing such plans.
5. As part of the regulatory requirements, the ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan establishes the PWD's notice of nondiscrimination on the basis of disability, designates a responsible employee to oversee PWD's obligations under title II of the ADA, and establishes a complaint procedure to ensure prompt resolution.
6. The ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan identifies policy, program, and physical barriers to accessibility, and provides a flexible and dynamic strategy for the City and its PWD in planning and implementing barrier removal solutions in facilities and rights-of-way managed by the PWD.
7. The ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan will provide guidance for the PWD to reasonably modify policies, practices, and procedures to avoid discrimination against people with disabilities.
8. The ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan is complete and has been delivered to the City.

9. Future budgeting and expenditures to pursue the barrier removal actions identified in this plan remain the purview of the City Council and Budget Committee and approval of this plan does not establish funding for such actions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City of Troutdale Public Works Department Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan, prepared by MIG, Inc. and dated October 2020, is approved.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
