



Plan Review Takeaways

- City and County values align with SRTS goals
 - o Active transportation, partnerships, recreation, environment
- Improving safety is a key priority for The Dalles transportation system.
 - o Goal 1A: Eliminate the number of fatal and serious crashes in the plan area.
 - Goal 1B: Develop a multi-modal transportation system that incorporates safety and operational improvements for bicyclists and pedestrians.
- Paths and trails are highlighted as a priority in The Dalles' plans.
 - Shared-use paths along Chenoweth Creek and Mill Creek, were identified in the 2006
 TSP, but have not been completed.
- The The Dalles TSP notes that there are limited east-west bicycle and pedestrian connections.
 - Calls for increasing connections between residential areas and schools as identified in the Blue Zones Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Action Plans.

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
