WHEREAS, ORS 294.338 (3) allows for the governing body to adopt a resolution to appropriate excess expenditures for a specific purpose or purposes if it declares the existence of an occurrence or condition that could not have been foreseen at the time of the preparation of the budget, and

**WHEREAS**, current market conditions have changed significantly since the budget was started and have caused unforeseen increases in costs, and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available from excess beginning balances over budget or through developer contributions.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council of the City of Lebanon herein declares the existence of an unforeseen occurrence or condition since the preparation of the City's 2021-2022 budget began.

<u>Section 2.</u> Authorizes the increase the following adjustment to the appropriations of the 2021-2022 budget:
