Stop the Drop/Community Clean-ups

Krummrich asked for clarification on the needs of the clean up at the mouth of Chenoweth Creek. Krummrich said removal of vegetation was a lot different than the monthly litter pickup. She said she would like to have more information.

Nelson said the Watershed Commission was looking for a few people. He said he had Drake contact Rachel Carter. Nelson said he will contact Drake and see what the plan is and contact Krummrich.

Krummrich said Grossman sent Randy Haines at Bicoastal Media in order to create a proposal. She said Grossman would bring the proposal back to the Committee

Prince said she had talked to the Mayor at the Beautification Award, and the Mayor asked the Committee to identify a couple people who might be interested in joining the Committee.

Nelson said he would contact Bruce Lumpier to see if he would be interested. Prince said she would talk to Scot Barker

Nelson said he'd like to see the City invest in planting trees city wide, beyond downtown street trees, investing in making neighborhoods more livable.


