WHEREAS, it is necessary to select a preferred alternative site in order to proceed with the in-depth investigation, design, and planning required to assure compliance with applicable state and local land use regulations, and in order to perform the thorough environmental assessment required for federally-funded projects under the National Environmental Policy Act; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to identify a preferred second alternative in order to avoid the expense and delay that would result if further investigation were to establish that the preferred alternative is not suitable;

## FIRST MOTION:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the <u>McDonald Site</u> shall be the preferred alternative for the proposed central transit station for the Lane Transit District; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the <u>I-HOP Site</u> shall be the preferred second alternative for the proposed transit station.
